How to Enroll

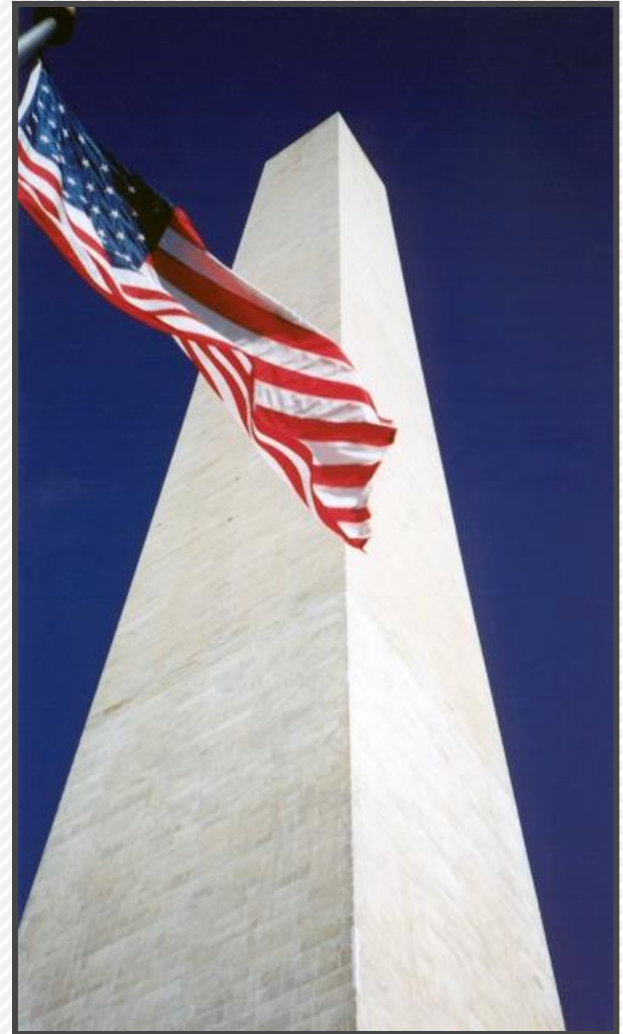
- 1) Register and Pay for your desired session at www.washcampus.edu
