

Ross School of Business Scholarship Fund for Students with Dyslexia Criteria and Application Outline

The Ross School of Business Scholarship Fund for Students with Dyslexia Scholarship was created in 2018 with intents to assist one full time Ross Undergraduate student that is diagnosed with Dyslexia at Ross – University of Michigan – Ann Arbor.

Amount of this award may vary year to year.

This is a one-time scholarship. Application required.

Criteria:

- Must be a full time Ross Undergraduate student (12+ credits).
- Must be able to show documented support of Dyslexia diagnosis.
- Must write a short essay.
- Abide by the Ross Honor Code and the Ross Student Code of Conduct.

Acceptable forms of supporting documented diagnosis:

1. If, registered with the Services for Students with Disabilities Office, www.ssd.umich.edu, with Dyslexia.
 - a. Copy of Accommodation Letter from Service for Students with Disabilities Office
AND
 - b. Signed Release of Information form

****Note:** by signing the Release of Information form, you will be allowing Ross Financial Aid to contact Service for Students with Disabilities to confirm your Dyslexia diagnosis. ******

OR

2. Letter from health professional
 - a. Letter from health professional must confirm Dyslexia diagnosis.
 - b. Must be on letterhead, dated, and signed by health professional.

1. 1-2 page single spaced essay on "Describing a time you failed and what you learned from it."
